# Deuteronomy 14: 22 – 29, 1 Corinthians 16: 1 – 4, 2 Corinthians 9: 6 – 14, Matthew 6: 1 - 4

# 1. Deuteronomy 14: 22 – 29

- Be sure to set aside a tenth
- Eat it in the presence of the Lord your God
- So that you may learn to revere the Lord your God always
- So that the Lord your God may bless you in all the work of your hands'

#### 2. 1 Corinthians 16: 1 - 4

- Each one set aside a sum of money in keeping with his income
- Planned and spontaneous giving
- Collection for God's people
- Where are my eyes focussing?
- Matthew 6: 24 You cannot serve both God and money

#### 3. 2 Corinthians 9: 6 - 14

- Sow and reap -
- Integrity, honesty and cheerfulness
- You will be made rich in every way
- Generosity results in thanksgiving to God!

#### 4. Matthew 6: 1 - 4

- Do not let your left hand know what your right hand is doing!
- Giving in secret!
- Giving will receive a reward!

# Read Deuteronomy 14: 22 – 29

- 1. What strikes you in these instructions given to God's people?
- 2. What is a tithe? What does it mean to eat the tithe in the presence of the Lord?
- 3. What are the reasons and blessings mentioned in these verses? How do they link with last week's passage in Matthew 6?
- 4. Who benefits from the tithes in these passages? What do we learn from this and who benefits?

#### Read 1 Corinthians 16: 1 – 4

- 1. What differences do we see in this New Testament church instruction compared to Deuteronomy?
- 2. How would giving work out in the early church context when there were slaves who may have received no income?
- 3. Is giving only about money? What other 'currencies' can we include in giving?
- 4. How important is transparency and accountable with money in God's family. Do you look at the financial statements prepared and distributed each month? Should we all take ownership of this?

### Read 2 Corinthians 9: 6 - 14

- 1. What does this passage say about our attitude towards giving?
- 2. How do we develop the ability to be cheerful givers?
- 3. What impact has generosity had in your life? How do we cultivate a culture of generosity as a family of God within our community?
- 4. What impact for God's Glory would generous hearts and actions have for the people we live, work and meet day to day?
